- Soft bristle brush
- Formula 409® + water
- Fantastik® + water
- Ivory® or Dawn® dish soap + water
- ALWAYS rinse w/water and pat dry

DON'Ts



- NO Eraser sponges
- NO Power washers
- NO Abrasives
- NO Silicones
- NO Full Strength Bleach
- NO Hard brushes

STEP 1:

For light soiling, a solution of 10% household liquid dish soap in warm water, applied with a soft damp cloth. Rub gently and rinse with a water-dampened cloth and pat dry.

STEP 2:

For heavy soiling, dampen a soft white cloth with a one-to-one (I:I) solution of *Formula 409® and water or *Fantastik® and water. Rub gently and rinse with a water-dampened cloth and pat dry.

STEP 3:

For more difficult stains, dampen a soft white cloth with a solution of household bleach (10% bleach and 90% water). Rub gently and rinse with a water-dampened cloth to remove bleach concentration and pat dry.
